- Sealed Calcium Chloride bids were opened and reviewed. Sicalco LTD and Scotwood Industries were the two bids received. The auditor will review the bids and will make her recommendation to the commission.
- Sealed bids for office supplies were opened. Speedy Office Solutions, Office Max, Office Depot, Conover Office Supplies and Quill submitted bids. The bids will be reviewed by the auditor and the commissioners before the commission awards the contract.
- Ryan Kent from Pre-Paid Legal Services gave a presentation about the services his company provides and will be scheduling appointments to meet with county employees for voluntary enrollment in the program.
- Discussion was held about miscalculations in 2010 in regards to the TransCanada Pipeline assessed valuation. The auditor is reviewing the information.
- The Lincoln County Commissioners attended the Boonslick Regional Planning Meeting in Warrenton from 10:00 a.m. until 1:00 a.m.
- Presiding Commissioner Colbert attended the Missouri Extension Center meeting in Troy on the evening on March 28, 2011.
