

THE JULY TERM HELD ON 4TH DAY OF OCTOBER 2011

The County Commission convened at 9:05 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on October 3, 2011. Present: Dan Colbert-Presiding Commissioner, Jim Mayes – Associate Commissioner District 1, Matt Bass-Associate Commissioner District 2, Crystal Hall-County Clerk, the following proceedings were held:

Sheriff Mike Krigbaum

- Presented letter from Dawn Urban, Division of Public Safety in regards to inspection violation with two hot water heaters in the kitchen of the jail. The division is waiting for installation permits from the subcontractor who installed them. The commissioners will get with the maintenance crew to get this resolved.
- Discussed the Sheriff's department operating over the forecasted budget for prisoner meals and medical expenses, year to date the department is operating within its total annual budget. The Sheriff informed the commissioners that according to a report from the FBI, the crime rate is up 19% in the county and he is significantly under staffed.
- The Sheriff gave updates on the recent DEA sweep targeting St. Louis and surrounding areas. 35 arrest warrants were issued in Lincoln County due to investigations conducted by the Lincoln County Narcotics Enforcement Team.
- Discussion on the concept of a regional jail was discussed. The Sheriff and the commissioners hope to be able to meet with counties that have similar jails at the MAC conference for more information.
- Budget needs for 2012 were discussed.
- Reviewed the requisition policy for clarification.

Recorder of Deeds, Dottie D. Crenshaw

- Presented a list of obsolete printers and computer equipment that she would like to remove from her inventory and take for recycling. Dottie is giving the maintenance department one computer that can no longer be used in the Records office.

- Proposed revision of Food Ordinance, updating address and date. Changing the contents to current date and adding fees for inspections.
