

THE JANUARY TERM HELD ON 7th DAY OF FEBRUARY 2012

The County Commission convened at 9:05 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on February 6, 2012. Present: Dan Colbert-Presiding Commissioner, Jim Mayes - Associate Commissioner District 1, Matt Bass-Associate Commissioner District 2, Crystal Hall-County Clerk, the following proceedings were held:

Invocation given by Commissioner Mayes.

Sheriff Mike Krigbaum

- The Sheriff reported that the Federal Marshal Prisoners are back effective January 31st. Currently there are 8 Federal prisoners, with hopes of housing more once a Federal Budget is approved. Currently there are a total of 92 prisoners in the County Jail.
- The Sheriff made the Commissioners aware of a pending complaint regarding the use of armed guards in County buildings.
- Discussed the security officers at the Justice Center. The Commission plans to have a private security firm in place by March 1st.

Hampel Road

- Commissioner Bass made a motion to allow Geeding Construction to close a section of Hampel Road south of Killarney Lane, contingent upon an executed repair agreement including a specific number of days for the repair. Commissioner Mayes seconded the motion. The ayes carried the motion.
