## **Highway Department**: Bruce Wallace and Don Lilley

- General road maintenance issues were discussed.
- Discussed overlaying procedures and the priority list for asphalt.
- Interviews to be conducted this week for the open Highway Department position.

## **Special Services:** Kelly Hardcastle

- Kelly informed the Commissioners that 3 potential tenants are interested in the Snow Hill Truss building.
- Discussed the expansion of GM. Kelly continues to work with other economic development groups to get suppliers to consider relocating to Lincoln County.
- Discussed the vacancy on the Work Force Investment Board.

#### **New Business**

• Commissioner Bass made a motion to give Ernie Painter the authority to enter into a contract for juvenile detention services on behalf of the county. ## **Leah Askey, Prosecuting Attorney**

- Discussed the easements for Hampel Road, concerning the Koch Pipeline repairs which require a road closure.

- Leah and George Gundy addressed a complaint which had been filed regarding the use of armed guards in County buildings. The Commission was informed that according to 571.030, the guards are allowed to carry unless told by the Governing body that they cannot.
- Discussed seizure of property. Leah will do some research into forfeitures and seizures of property and present the Commission with an agreement at a future date.
