Special Services: Kelly Hardcastle

- Hardcastle reported on meeting with BNSF regarding a potential rail spur.
- Hardcastle reported on recent RCGA meeting. Discussed the report regarding the airport from the FAA stating that the site selected by CMT doesn't satisfy FAA requirements. The site is not eligible as it is too close to the airport in Bowling Green.

Highway Department: Bruce Wallace and Don Lilley

- General road maintenance issues were discussed.
- Discussed logistics for oil purchases for asphalt jobs.
- Temporary easements are being obtained to begin working on Mette Road.
- Milling work has been completed on Mette Road and Elm Tree Road at the Ninth Grade Center. Patching is expected to be completed later this week.
