

THE OCTOBER TERM HELD ON THE 2nd DAY OF OCTOBER 2012

The County Commission convened at 9:05 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on October 1, 2012. Present: Dan Colbert-Presiding Commissioner, Jim Mayes - Associate Commissioner District 1, Matt Bass-Associate Commissioner District 2, Crystal Hall—County Clerk, the following proceedings were held:

Invocation given by Rev. Gary Jackson.

Sheriff Mike Krigbaum

- Krigbaum reports that the new transport van has been ordered.
- Discussed establishing a SWAT Fund. The Sheriff will work with the Auditor in creating the SWAT fund, which will distribute funds for the regional SWAT team consisting of LCSD, Troy PD, and Moscow Mills PD.
- Krigbaum is waiting on approval from the Prosecuting Attorney's office for the contracts for municipalities.
- Currently there are approximately 100 prisoners in the jail. 12 ICE and 11 Marshall's.
- Commissioner Mayes made a motion to go into closed session to discuss personnel issues. Commissioner Bass seconded. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes to enter closed session. Motion carried.
- Commissioner Bass made a motion to leave closed session. Commissioner Mayes second. A roll call vote was taken, all ayes to leave closed session. Motion carried.

New Business

- The Commission opened bids for the Bridge Deck Resurfacing Project. One bid was opened and read aloud from Missouri Petroleum for \$18,499.20.

Ministerial Activities/Road and County Property Inspection:

- Roads Inspected: Gravens, Mansion, McClay, Sand Hill, McIntosh, Hill Creek, Snyder, Cave Farm, Stepanek, and Fairgrounds.

- The minutes from October 1st and October 2nd have been reviewed. Commissioner Jim Mayes made the motion to approve the minutes as presented; Commissioner Matt Bass seconded the motion. The ayes carried the motion.
