Kristen Burkemper, Treasurer

• Burkemper presented the January Treasurer's Report, March gas and sales tax reports. Burkemper reports that sales tax was down 5.1% for the month, and down 5% for the year. Gas tax is up 16.9% for the month, and up 0.1% for the year.

Jerry Fox, Collector

- Presented tax affidavits from February for the Commissioners to sign.
- Fox is working on the third year tax offerings.

Unfinished/New Business

- Bids were opened and read aloud to replace 7 HVAC units from the following: Herbig Mechanical \$30, 330.00; Grand Oaks \$31,024.00; Menne's \$32,029.85; Brush's \$22,041.00; and Schieffer's \$18,675.00.
- Proposals were opened and read aloud for the tractor and mower. Proposals were received from: Sydenstricker \$70,535.39 for a John Deere 6140D with mower, \$63,524.80 for a John Deere 6115D with mower; Ennis Implement, \$74,050.00 for a Case IH Maxxum 115 with a Landpride mower, \$74,050.00 for a Case IH Maxxum 115 with a Rhino mower, \$69.650.00 for a Case IH Farmall 125A with option of Landpride or Rhino mower; Mordt Tractor \$82,882 for a New Holland T6.165 with mower.
- Proposals were opened and read aloud for a skid steer. The Commission requested proposals list a new machine price, repair costs, repurchase price, and total purchase price. The Following are the total purchase prices proposed: Sydenstricker \$62,976.13 for a John Deere 328E; Fabick \$25,349.00 for a CAT 246C; Bobcat of St. Louis \$33,845.00 for a \$630, and \$35,695.00 for a \$650.
- Bids were opened and read aloud for asphalt materials. G&M \$42.50 per ton for BPI and \$42.25 for bit base; Pace Construction \$44.00 per ton for BPI and \$44.00 for bit base.
- One bid from Zone was opened and read aloud for striping of roads for \$497.11 per mile.
- One bid from Scotwood Industries was opened and read aloud for Calcium Chloride. Scotwood proposed \$0.961 per gallon for 38% calcium; \$1.00 per gallon for 30% magnesium; \$0.88 per gallon for 35% calcium.
