Invocation given by Kelly Hardcastle.

• The minutes from May 6th and May 7th have been reviewed. Commissioner Bass made a motion to approve the minutes as presented; Commissioner Galloway seconded the motion. The ayes carried the motion.

Special Services: Kelly Hardcastle

- Hardcastle reported on his recent trip with the Troy Chamber to Washington D.C. The Chamber group along with Hardcastle met with Senators McCaskill and Blunt as well as Congressman Luetkemeyer. Hardcastle indicated that Healthcare reform was a large topic of conversation when meeting with all of the officials.
- Discussed economic development, there is a potential contract on the Snow Hill Truss Building.

Highway Department: Bruce Wallace

- A resident is willing to cost share to pave part of Giles Road. Wallace is to measure the road from 47 to Trackside and report back to the Commission, as the Commission wishes not to have any more skips in pavement.
- Discussed the fleet of graders. The number of employees trained to operate and how many hours are currently on each machine.
- Spraying of calcium chloride is scheduled to begin this week.
