Invocation given by Kelly Hardcastle.

• The minutes from May 13th and May 14th have been reviewed. Commissioner Galloway made a motion to approve the minutes as presented; Commissioner Bass seconded the motion. The ayes carried the motion.

Special Services: Kelly Hardcastle

- Hardcastle reported that Brooks Brothers has purchased the Snow Hill Truss property and will be adding 20,000 square feet for paint booths. Brooks Brothers will take advantage of the Enhanced Enterprise Zone adding 6 employees in 2014.
- Hardcastle is finalizing paperwork with FEMA changing flood maps regarding Elderado and Whitcomb Branch.
- Hardcastle has been advised by the Missouri Emergency Response Commission (MERC) that there will be no additional HMEP funds forthcoming; and the CEPF money is the sole source of income that the county will receive.
