The County Commission convened at 9:05 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on July 30, 2013. Present: Dan Colbert-Presiding Commissioner, EuGene Galloway- Associate Commissioner District 1, Matt Bass-Associate Commissioner District 2, Crystal Hall—County Clerk, the following proceedings were held:

Invocation given by Commissioner Bass.

Highway Department: Bruce Wallace and Don Lilley

- General maintenance issues were discussed.
- Wallace commented on the excellent quality of the work performed by Zone, the striping contractor. Janice Kisor to prepare a list of roads that need striping sooner than originally scheduled for safety reasons.
- Wallace will contact Cornerstone Excavating regarding the easement for Calvary Church at the Highway Department property. Commissioner Colbert suggested that a survey be done to clearly mark the highway right of way at the east/west property line on the north side allowing for a 25-30 foot easement, as an alternative to running the line across the existing gas and phone lines within the original 15 foot easement.
- Discussed a trailer that is one year old needing repairs. The cost of repairs is approximately \$800.00, plus freight. Commissioner Colbert will contact manufacturer to see if this would be covered under warranty.
- Lilley is working on a list of bridges that are not included in the MODOT inventory.
- Wallace has contacted Troop C requesting a scale to weigh trucks on Myers Road for overloading, causing damage to the road.
- Discussed mechanical problems with the Mack dump trucks and the need to update the truck fleet in the next year or two.
- Paving has been completed on Adelhardt, Fairgrounds, Bell, Point, Keelstone and Paulsmeyer Roads.
- Discussed rock washing into the church yard at Zoar Cemetery. Wallace will schedule crews to clean up the area.
- Wallace will have crews remove a tree at Gravens and Creech School Road.
- Wallace and Lilley will begin evaluating roads for pavement work for 2014.
- A request has been made for a speed limit and stop sign at Linns Mill Road and Trackside Farm. A request was also made for a stop sign on S. Ridge Road at Lottie Drive

- Harrell will be sending dispatchers to Troop C for training next week.

- Clary reports the repairs to the ceiling on 2 South at the Courthouse have been completed.
- Siebert continues to have issues with a compressor for a roof top ac unit at the Justice Center. The manufacturer sent wrong parts last week.
- One Centurylink phone needs to be replaced in the Prosecutor's Office. Siebert will contact Centurylink to make arrangements under the maintenance protection plan.
- Siebert intends to wax floors next week in the Justice Center as there will be a light docket.
