- Burkemper presented the June Sales Tax and May Gas Tax Reports. Burkemper reports that sales tax is down 8% for the year, and gas tax is down 2.8% for the year.

Unfinished/New Business

- Bids were opened and read aloud for the large format printer/scanner for the Recorder of Deeds office from the following: Konica/Minolta \$16,999.00; Dacom \$11,691.00; Rotolite \$14,895.00; and MDS \$13,329.00. A tab sheet of pricing and options will be compiled.
- One bid was opened and read aloud for fuel pumps. Neumayer submitted a bid for \$49,784.00.

- Commissioner Bass made a motion to execute the professional services agreement for construction engineering for the Lakeview NID project from Trabue, Hansen & Hinshaw, Inc. Commissioner Galloway second. The ayes carried the motion.
