The County Commission convened at 9:05 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on October 11, 2016. #### Highway Department: Bruce Wallace and Don Lilley

- General maintenance issues were discussed.
- Emma Epplin-Birdsell and Jay Gourley were present to discuss the issues with an entrance pipe on East Rock Springs Road. Don Lilley and Jay Gourley will meet with the landowner in an effort to resolve flooding issues. The Commission wishes to put the entrance back to the natural crossing or install a new pipe. The current pipe will be removed.
- Reviewed MODOT pricing for John Deere graders.
- Discussed installing chevron signs on Davis Road near the bridge.
- Discussed score sheets for roads for the 2017 budget.
- Wallace says he is waiting on the phone company and electric company to move utilities on Fairview Church Road to finish the project.

## **Unfinished/New Business**

• Met with Paula Gough and Kevin James from MODOT and Senator Jeanie Riddle and State Representative Randy Pietzman. Discussed proposed safety improvements on Highway 61 North. Several concerned citizens were present and voiced their displeasure for the proposed J-turns. Gough stated that J-turns are 90% effective in reducing fatalities, and that the location, Auburn Junction, is one of the highest crash locations. Gough will investigate the cost for extending acceleration and deceleration lanes instead of the J-turns to see if that option is feasible.
