- Commissioner Mueller made a motion to leave closed session. Commissioner Bass seconded. A roll call vote was taken. All ayes to leave closed session. Motion carried. While in closed session, the following vote was had: Commissioner Mueller made a motion to accept the dismissal with prejudice of John C. Askey v. Lincoln County Sheriff's Office, Case# 17-CV-0072-DDN and execute a general & mutual release of all claims against the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office & Lincoln County. Commissioner Bass seconded.
