Eric Tapley, Highway Department

- Discussed general road maintenance and improvements: Asphalt has been completed on Giles and Trakside Farm Roads. Crews have began asphalt on Godt and Schemmer Roads today. The asphalt crews will be working 12 hour shifts to complete the asphalt projects. All graders are out blading road to road. Gravens Road is almost complete and set to open back up soon. Culvert and ditch work is being done on Schemmer, Sugar Grove, Ridge, and Pear Tree Roads. Truck# 1720 has been towed to Truck Centers for repairs. Meeting Cuivre River Electric on site tomorrow on Mette Road to discuss a future project.
- Commissioner Kaimann made a motion to dispose of the following items from the Highway Department inventory: 100 gallon fuel tank, asset tag# 500226 and 100 gallon fuel tank, asset tag# 500232, dispose via recycling. Commissioner Bass second. All ayes to carry the motion.
