- Hall presented a report of the total county population as well as the population broken down by commission district as reported by the 2020 Decennial Census.
- The total Lincoln County population was 59,574 persons, 28,552 of which live in Commission District 1 and 31,022 live in Commission District 2.
- As of December 14, 2021, Lincoln County has 40,120 total registered voters of which 19,530 live in Commission District 1 and 20,590 live in Commission District 2.
- Hall recommended no change to the Commission District apportionments.
