The following proceedings were held:

Invocation given by Commissioner Bass.

New Business

- Commissioner Mueller made a motion to approve the open session minutes from January 25, and 26, 2021. Commissioner Bass second. All ayes to carry the motion.

Julie Rodgers, Economic Development Director

- Presented Economic Development activity report and updates on ongoing projects and business expansions.
- Rodgers submitted sites to Alliance STL for “Project Elsa”.
- Rodgers helping to coordinate micro-enterprise opportunities for Ranken Tech Workforce Development Center.

Jim Sharp, Emergency Management Director

- Discussed COVID-19 matters; reported on mass vaccination event.

Adam Stanek, Floodplain Manager

- Update on floodplain violations, two current violations: 155 Guitar Dr. and 71 Crenshaw; active permits, 43 issued.
- Stanek working with ArcGIS and ESRI on creating a lease lot map; most least lots were renewed for 2021.
- County Floodplain Ordinance review is still underway with Floodproofing.com.

- Sheriff Harrell reported the jail is currently housing 148 total inmates; 54 Marshals.

- Discussed utilizing ArcGIS for importing local crime data.
