New Business

- Discussed general road maintenance and improvements: All trucks are hauling rock to various county roads and all graders are operating; Tapley met with Walter Burkemper on safety improvements at Meier and Brevator Roads. Tree removal will begin along Meier Road on April 18th; Shouldering Kitson Road and hauling away excess dirt to S. Chantilly Road; Continuing to widen remaining portion of S.
