

THE APRIL TERM HELD ON THE 10th DAY OF MAY 2022

The County Commission convened at 9:00 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on May 3, 2022. Present: Joseph Kaimann, Presiding Commissioner; Mike Mueller, Associate Commissioner District 1; Matt Bass, Associate Commissioner District 2; and Taylor Wilmes, Deputy Clerk.

The following proceedings were held:

Invocation given by Commissioner Bass.

Eric Tapley, Highway Department

- Discussed general road maintenance and improvements: Ditching needs to be done on a portion of Frenchman's Bluff Road along flooding area; Repairs needed on the shoulder of a box culvert off Sycamore Bend Road; Kitson Road dirt work near completion once grading is finished this week.
- Asphalt overlays have begun; Repairs were completed to the paver; Crews are overlaying Thornhill Cemetery Road and Frenchman's Bluff Road this week.
- Mennemeyer Road bridge replacement project utilizing BRO funds has been approved by MoDOT.
- Discussed personnel matters; Jacob Fisk did not fulfill his two-week notice. He has left employment.
- Commissioner Bass made a motion to hire Jack Price, as a seasonal employee, at \$14 per hour. Commissioner Mueller second. All ayes to carry the motion.
- Commissioner Mueller made a motion to hire Blake Baragiola as a full-time employee, at \$17 per hour, with a 90-day probationary period. Commissioner Bass second. All ayes to carry the motion.
- Commissioner Mueller made a motion to hire David Owens as a full-time employee, at \$17 per hour, with a 90-day probationary period. Commissioner Bass second. All ayes to carry the motion.

Adam Stanek, Emergency Management Director**Quentin Laws, Floodplain Administrator**

- Discussed recent trainings attended including G272 Warning Coordination and G2300 Intermediate Emergency Operations Center Functions; Upcoming trainings include: MGT 460 Planning for Disaster Debris Management, and G205 Recovery from Disaster, The Local Community Role.
- Stanek reported CEPF funds that were submitted for have been approved from 2018-2019, 2019-2020, and 2020-2021.
- EMPG Grant third quarter claim has been submitted and approved.
- Stanek discussed the search operation off N. Ethlyn Road; EMA coordinated the search efforts with multiple local agencies.
- Stanek reported the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office has requested the EMA department to assist at the upcoming LCSO Leadership Camp in June.
- Laws presented an update on floodplain violations and permits; 46 E. Timberlake owner and leasee have been contacted by Laws. Leasee has agreed to get the lot cleaned up and to bring lot into compliance.

New/Unfinished Business

- Commissioner Mueller made a motion to approve the open session minutes from April 18, 19, 25, and 26, 2022, and May 2, and 3, 2022. Commissioner Kaimann second. All ayes to carry the motion.
- Commissioner Mueller made a motion to dispose of the following inventory items: Road & Bridge inventory: Stihl MS251 Chainsaw, inventory tag# 6215, and Bosch Circular Saw, inventory tag# 3637, dispose of items via trash. Building & Grounds inventory: Blue Salt Spreader, inventory tag# 3932, dispose via trash. Commissioner Bass second. All ayes to carry the motion.
