Eric Tapley, Highway Department

- Discussed general road maintenance and improvements: Culverts are being replaced on Colbert Lane, and Creech and Argenville Roads this week; Huber Lane box culvert to be set within the next week
- Discussed status of asphalt projects: Asphalt on Timberland Road to be completed today; N. Rock Church Road to be completed this week.
- Tapley reported the US-61 Outer Road project ROW and preliminary plans have been submitted by Bartlett & West to MoDOT.
- Commissioner Mueller made a motion to dispose of a sweepster broom attachment, inventory tag# 500139, via Purple Wave. Commissioner Bass second.
