

THE JULY TERM HELD ON THE 12th DAY OF SEPTEMBER 2022

The County Commission convened at 9:00 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on September 6, 2022. Present: Joseph Kaimann, Presiding Commissioner; Mike Mueller, Associate Commissioner District 1; Matt Bass, Associate Commissioner District 2; and Taylor Wilmes, Deputy Clerk. The following proceedings were held:

Invocation given by Commissioner Bass.

Eric Tapley, Highway Department

- Giles Road residents were in attendance to discuss the progress of paving the South end of Giles Road and the status of repairs to the low water crossing.
- Discussed general road maintenance and improvements: Culverts are being installed on S. Moore School, Sycamore Bend, N. Rock Church, and Cave Farm Roads; Kitson Road ditch work, and seeding & strawing has been completed.
- Discussed status of asphalt projects: Paving has been completed on N. Rock Church and Timberland Roads; Paving on Cave Farm Road is in progress.
