- Rodgers has helped coordinate a countywide water and wastewater meeting scheduled for April 18, 2023.


Quentin Laws, Floodplain Administrator

There being no other business before the County Commission at this time, the meeting thereupon was adjourned until Monday, March 27, 2023.




