

THE OCTOBER TERM HELD ON THE 4th DAY OF DECEMBER 2023

The County Commission convened at 9:00 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on November 27, 2023. Present: Joseph Kaimann, Presiding Commissioner; Mike Mueller, Associate Commissioner District 1; Matt Bass, Associate Commissioner District 2; and Kenny Schulte, County Clerk. The following proceedings were held:

Invocation given by Commissioner Bass.

Eric Tapley, Highway Department

- Road construction projects: All culverts are installed on Saddle Ridge Rd that cross the road. Work will begin on removing trees once the weather cooperates and utility locates are completed. Shouldering is underway on Clark Rd and will be followed by Myers, Elm Tree, Sand Run, Carter, Scott, and Gravens Rds.
- The Bridge of Hope parking lot asphalt is planned for later this week.
- Three RFQs were received for civil engineering on the Mennemeyer Road Bridge Project: BRO-B057(21): Hutchison Engineering Inc, Howe Company LLC, and McClure Engineering. McClure was the top-rated consultant and MoDOT has given approval to start negotiations for a contract with McClure. Waiting for approval from MoDOT on utility work within the project to proceed to bid letting.
- Safety concerns were addressed pertaining to the intersection of Auburn Ridge Dr and Kneiss Ct. There is little sight distance to traffic pulling onto Gibison Rd from Auburn Ridge Dr. Safety concerns were also addressed concerning the intersection of Pear Tree Rd at Oak Tree Ln.
- The following equipment needs repairs: Volve DD70HF asphalt roller, Etnyre distributor truck, and asphalt paver.

Robert Henebry, Project Management

- Henebry presented his report on current projects: Discussed current bid review: Janitorial Supplies, Culvert Pipes, Auto Parts, and Vending Services are all due on December 5, 2023, Jail Improvement to Booking and Water Waste Water Engineering go out to bid on December 6, 2023, Inmate Monitoring System is due to be awarded at the beginning on 2024, Pole Barn Expansion closed on October 17, 2023 and all bids have been rejected, and the Website RFQ is under review; Reported Sheriff's Department will order one LPR (license plate recognition), and phone extensions are being updated; Justice Center will have meetings pertaining to the change in building use and controlled access; Highway Department electrical, plumbing, and HVAC begins this week. Controlled access system contract needs signed. Working on GPS updates for the vehicles and equipment; Crisis Stabilization Center fire alarm systems and data cable completing and inspection this week with drywall to follow. Siding and soffit are getting installed this week; Courthouse temporarily relocated the County Clerk's office for remodel. Construction begins today. Fire alarm cable run this week. .

There being no other business before the County Commission at this time, the meeting thereupon was adjourned until Tuesday, December 5, 2023.
