

THE APRIL TERM HELD ON THE 15<sup>th</sup> DAY OF MAY 2023

The County Commission convened at 9:00 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on May 09, 2023.

Present: Joseph Kaimann, Presiding Commissioner; Mike Mueller, Associate Commissioner District 1; & Aimee Vann, Deputy Clerk. Absent: Matt Bass, Associate Commissioner District 2  
The following proceedings were held:

Invocation given by Commissioner Mueller.

**Eric Tapley, Highway Department**

- Discussed general road maintenance and improvements: Crews are currently working on Creech Rd and John Creech Rd; Asphalt patching completed on McIntosh Hill Rd, Brevator Rd, and Creech School Rd; Asphalt patching on N. Lindsey Rd, Pieper Rd, and Corso Rd to be completed this week; Graders will be back up and running later this week; Creech Lane had a culvert damaged by the intense rain over the weekend; Asphalt milling crews have worked on Elm Tree Rd, Hampel Rd, Himmel Rd, and Maryknoll Rd. Asphalt crews are working on Elm Tree Rd, followed by Himmel Rd, Keelstone Rd, and Maryknoll Rd; Discussed the possibility of paving a section of Hampel Rd within Moscow Mills city limits, while patching the bridge at the city/county maintenance line. Mayor Flannigan is in favor of the paving.
- Discussed Mennemeyer Rd bridge replacement project, BRO-B057 (21). McClure Engineering will be meeting with residents on impact.
- Discussed MTFC loan pushback.
- Discussed lending a truck with fuel tank, to Randy Siebert, for one week of DARE Camp.

**Robert Henebry, Project Coordinator**

- Henebry presented his report on current projects: Discussed upcoming bid lettings; Discussed update on Sheriff's Department evidence building addition/remodel. Lighting in the DEA cage is complete; Lighting in the lab will be completed this week; The Highway Department door has been replaced; Data units to be installed this week and next.
- Discussed update on the Collector's office remodel. Grid ceiling and painting are complete; HVAC will install ducts and vents this week, Electrician to install all ceiling items; Collector's office should be completely moved back into room 103 by the end of June.
- Fleet maintenance for April 2023 was \$16,591.00. Gas expense was \$39,804.00. This equates to 14,372 gallons of fuel and 121,406 miles driven.

There being no other business before the County Commission at this time, the meeting thereupon was adjourned until Tuesday, May 16, 2023.
