

THE APRIL TERM HELD ON THE 22nd DAY OF MAY 2023

The County Commission convened at 9:00 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on May 16, 2023.

Present: Joseph Kaimann, Presiding Commissioner; Mike Mueller, Associate Commissioner District 1; Matt Bass, Associate Commissioner District 2; and Aimee Vann, Deputy Clerk.

The following proceedings were held:

Invocation given by Commissioner Bass.

Jeremy Partl, Highway Department

- Discussed overlays; 27 miles in total to overlay this year, 10.1 miles are complete; Patched the bridge deck on Hampel Rd, Began overlay on Himmel Rd; Patching done over pipes on Brevator Rd, McIntosh Rd, N. Lindsey Rd, and Pieper Rd; Milling to continue on Keelstone Rd, and Maryknoll Rd.
- Presented remaining items to be completed on Creech Rd and John Creech Rd.
- Right of Way meeting for the Mennemeyer Bridge project is on May 31, 2023, at 11:00 am. The meeting will take place at Mennemeyer Bridge.
- Recertification of the Safety and Boom on the bucket truck to be completed this week.
- Warning signs were placed around the county in areas that are susceptible to potential flash flooding.
- Discussed removal of debris from Sandy Slough Rd and Eagles Landing Drive now that the water has receded.

Julie Rogers, Economic Development

- Rogers was not on the agenda.
- Discussed the Office of Broadband Development and the Boonslick Regional Planning Commission meeting on May 22, 2023, 1:30 p.m., held at the Lincoln County Health Department. Regarding the 'Connecting All Missourians' Initiative.
- Discussed future meeting with Solar Wind Farm representative.

Robert Henebry, Project Coordinator

- Henebry presented his report on current projects: Discussed current bid reviews and upcoming bid lettings; Discussed potential change of Sheriff's Department grant money allocation; Reported that 13 (thirteen) pieces of Highway Department equipment have data units installed; Met with contractor regarding Highway Department remodel and Bridge of Hope building to review bids; Reported on status of wall in Economic Development office.
- Reported on the status of the Collector's Office remodel: Drop ceiling is being installed this week; Furniture has been ordered and will arrive June 20, 2023.
- Reported on the status of the Sheriff's Office evidence building addition/remodel: lab lighting is complete, cabinet bid has been received, sewer line is in full operation.

Dan Heavin, Coroner

- Heavin was not on the agenda. He stopped by to give an update on deaths that the Coroner's office has dealt with for the beginning of 2023. He also alerted the Commission to a new drug that is beginning to reach Lincoln County: Xylazine. This drug does not respond to Narcan for overdoses.

- Resident, Teresa (and Charles) Whitford, asked the Commission to ascertain whether a portion of Old Town Rd (near Briscoe Rd) is private or County property.
- Commissioner Bass made a motion to appoint Dale Black and Charlie Kaimann to the Board of Equalization for 2023. Commissioner Mueller second. All ayes to carry the motion.
