

THE JULY TERM HELD ON THE 24th DAY OF JULY 2023

The County Commission convened at 9:00 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on July 18, 2023. Present: Joseph Kaimann, Presiding Commissioner; Matt Bass, Associate Commissioner District 2; and Kenneth Schulte, County Clerk. Absent: Mike Mueller, Associate Commissioner District 1. The following proceedings were held:

Invocation given by Commissioner Bass.

Eric Tapley, Highway Department

- Discussed road construction projects and culvert replacements on Bell, Davis, and Scott roads
- Asphalt on St. Alphonsus, Paulsmeyer and Nineveh roads are complete.
- Utility Permits for Spectrum on Lilley Lane, Barrett Road, Windy Hill Road, Gladney Lane, and Harmony Grove roads were signed and approved.

Robert Henebry, Project Coordinator

- Discussed current projects: Stripping at the Justice Center and CID buildings.
- Bridges of Hope and Highway Department projects are starting this week.
- Report on other remodeling efforts within the courthouse.
- Discussed bid reviews for Sheriff's Office Freezer bids.

New/Unfinished Business

- Paula Gough, District Engineer, and Jeff Niemeyer, Area Engineer, Missouri Department of Transportation (MODOT), were present to discuss the outer road project. Gough reiterated that construction could not begin without prior approval from MODOT, otherwise whatever was constructed could not become part of the MODOT system. Gough emphasized that she had an agreement with the county and needed complete plans before any construction could take place, otherwise the road may not be eligible for cost share. Commissioners informed Gough they were working with MODOT, but had no control what a private citizen wanted to do on their property.

There being no other business before the County Commission at this time, the meeting thereupon was adjourned until July 25, 2023, at 9:00 a.m.
