

THE JULY TERM HELD ON THE 7th DAY OF AUGUST 2023

The County Commission convened at 9:00 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on August 1, 2023.

Present: Joseph Kaimann, Presiding Commissioner; Mike Mueller, Associate Commissioner District 1; Matt Bass, Associate Commissioner District 2; Kenneth Schulte, County Clerk; and Aimee Vann, Deputy Clerk.

The following proceedings were held:

Invocation given by Commissioner Bass.

Eric Tapley, Highway Department

- Discussed current road construction projects: Crisis Stabilization Center and Highway Department expansion; Culvert replacements scheduled for Myers Rd and Hammett Rd; All graders are blading this week; Asphalt crews are beginning with pug rock on Davis Rd. Pug rock operations are scheduled to last a few weeks.
- Tapley and the Commissioners will meet to discuss updates pertaining to the Outer Rd Project.
- Discuss utility permit requests for Spectrum pertaining to the following: John Creech Rd, Creech Rd, Myers Rd, E. Rock Springs Rd, Hampel Rd, Himmel Rd, and Carter Rd.
- The Mennemeyer Bridge project is waiting on one more easement to be procured. Once this has been done, McCluer Engineering will begin final plans and approval.
- Discussed 3.5% price increase on cooperative salt purchasing agreement with Compass Minerals.

Robert Henebry, Project Management

- Henebry presented his report on current projects: Discussed current bid review; Reported painting and new kitchen equipment installation at the Sheriff's Department; Highway Department and Crisis Stabilization Center building pads in progress; Justice Center paving is still in process due to multiple scheduling conflicts; Courthouse to receive some landscape adjustments; Assessor's office construction continuing.
- Sprinkler tests were completed at the Sheriff's Department, Courthouse, and Justice Center.
- Fleet maintenance for July 2023 was \$8,082.99. Gas expense was 32,000.72. This equates to 12,839 gallons of fuel and 119,293 miles driven.

New/Unfinished Business

- Resident, Fletcher King, spoke with the commissioners regarding his opinion on SB190 and what to do with the marijuana tax revenue once received.

There being no other business before the County Commission at this time, the meeting thereupon was adjourned until Monday, August 7, 2023.
