The County Commission convened at 9:00 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on September 18, 2023. Present: Joseph Kaimann, Presiding Commissioner; Mike Mueller, Associate Commissioner District 1; Matt Bass, Associate Commissioner District 2; Kenneth Schulte, County Clerk; and Aimee Vann, Deputy Clerk.

The following proceedings were held:

Invocation given by Pastor Larry Gallagher of Asbury Methodist.

New Business

- Commissioner Mueller made a motion to approve the open session minutes from September 5, and 11, 2023. Commissioner Bass second. All ayes to carry the motion.
- Cynthia Davenport introduced herself to the commission. She is interested in becoming the County Counsel.

Julie Rodgers, Economic Development

- Discussed requests for information that have been submitted; Discussed the status of ongoing projects and business expansions; Discussed various infrastructure activities and industrial site development; and discussed recent and upcoming community events.


Quentin Laws, Emergency Management and Floodplain

- Laws provided an update on recent meetings: Officer Involved Shooting (OIS) after action meeting on September 5, 2023; Growing Tree Preschool 'Stop the Bleed' training on September 6, 2023; Elsberry Retirement Home Evacuation exercise on September 12, 2023; County leadership training on September 13, 2023; Interviews for Part Time Administrative Assistant on September 14, 2023; East-West Gateway Security meeting on September 16, 2023; Governors committee meeting on the future of emergency management for the State of Missouri on September 18, 2023. Laws was asked to be a member of this committee.
- Reported on multiple instances of emergency management being called to service: September 7, 2023, a school bus accident that occurred at Highway 47 and Main Street in Troy, MO. Emergency Management responded and conducted reunification per CEOP and Troy RIII response plans, under MO Highway Patrol investigation; September 8, 2023, a school bus accident on Highway H in Troy, MO. Emergency Management responded and coordinated multiple (4) medical transports for injured riders. This is considered a mass casualty event and is under MO Highway Patrol investigation; September 11, 2023, a gas spill on Merlin Drive, Troy, MO. The emergency shutoff was activated, Missouri Emergency Response Commission (MERC) was contacted and clean up proceeded; September 12, 2023, report of a person shot and man down in a field on Highway W, drone team and command response was activated. The report was unfounded; September 13, 2023, a bad traffic stop resulting in standoff occurred in Winfield, MO; The Wright City drone team was activated, and the person was taken into custody; September 14, 2023, chemical spill on the Mississippi River, MERC and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers was alerted. The Environmental Protection Agency is investigating; September 16, 2023, law enforcement was called to a search in Moscow Mills, MO. A large perimeter was set up with the Wright City drone team activated. Complaints were received pertaining to the drone coverage. The suspect was not located.
- Floodplain Administration: FEMA NFIP inspection occurred and passed as a level 8 on September 15, 2023; FEMA Region VII visit will be held in October.
- Grants received YTD in total \$237,316.84.
- Upcoming events: Election Security Grant submission; MERC LEPD executives training on September 19, 2023; First Responders Troy R3 meeting on September 20, 2023; 911 Board Meeting on September 21, 2023; Mass Evacuation training is October 2-7, 2023, Laws will be out of town. Dan Heavin will be on-call; First Responders Trunk or Treat to be held on October 28, 2023; and Elected officials training.
- 2023 EOP update and the radio grant (partially received) installation is in process.

There being no other business before the County Commission at this time, the meeting thereupon was adjourned until Monday, September 25, 2023.
