Invocation given by Commissioner Bass.


#### Eric Tapley, Highway Department

- Road construction projects: Fred Norton Rd is now open, seeding and strawing to occur soon; Six-foot box culverts are being replaced on Point Rd and Rahmier Rd this week; Larger diameter culverts have been ordered in anticipation of Bell Rd, S. Moore School Rd, and Giles Rd; All graders are currently running; Asphalt crews have completed Davis and Penrod Rds.; Rumble strips have been added to Penrod Rd per resident request; Patching on Hammet and Fred Norton Rds. is complete; Patching soon to occur on Prairie Rd, Linns Mill Rd, Cave Farm Rd, N. Ridge Rd, Brevator Rd, and Sand Run Rds.; Researching magnesium chloride to control dust along county roads; Removed trees and will grind the stumps on Fairview Church Rd.
- Elsberry School requested help in clearing the area of Duckett and Tickridge Rds. as it is quite dangerous for school busses to travel.
- Mennemeyer Rd Bridge project is currently waiting on all right-of-way's to be cleared.
- The Outer Rd project details and progression were discussed. The four-leg traffic study has been completed and all information has been sent over to the Missouri Department of Transportation and is pending review. Approval or denial is expected to be received by the end of October.

#### Robert Henebry, Project Management


- Henebry presented his report on current projects: Discussed current bid review: Highway Department Pole Barn is due on October 24, 2023, Concrete finishings at the Justice Center, Jail improvements to booking, Janitorial Supplies, Culvert pipes, and Website Design is due on October 31, 2023; Reported Sheriff's Department parking lot has been sealed and will be striped within the next few weeks. Received quote for generator of \$5,124.46. This will place the generator in great, operational functionality; Highway Department walls, trusses, and sheeting have been completed. Site is ready for metal, stone, plumbing, and electrical. Removal of old windows and doors will begin soon to start the interior remodel; Crisis Stabilization Center roof has been completed and electricians have started installation. HVAC has begun and will be followed by fire suppression. Windows are in stock and ready to install. Gas service for the main furnaces will be ordered soon. The stonework will begin toward weeks end; The radiators in the Recorder's office have been removed. Martin will begin remodeling this week. All boilers were purged and are operational. Drop ceiling was completed in Room 308.
- Fleet maintenance software subscription (Fleetio) is due for renewal. The total cost for the year is \$7,920 and has been approved for renewal by the Commission.

There being no other business before the County Commission at this time, the meeting thereupon was adjourned until Tuesday, October 17, 2023.
