

THE OCTOBER TERM HELD ON THE 6th DAY OF NOVEMBER 2023

The County Commission convened at 9:00 a.m., pursuant to adjournment on October 31, 2023.

Present: Joseph Kaimann, Presiding Commissioner; Mike Mueller, Associate Commissioner District 1; Matt Bass, Associate Commissioner District 2; Kenny Schulte, County Clerk, and Aimee Vann, Deputy Clerk.

The following proceedings were held:

Invocation given by Commissioner Bass.

Eric Tapley, Highway Department

- Road construction projects: Saddle Ridge construction will begin next week; Bridge of Hope parking lot grading is complete; Shouldering begins this week; Excavator is currently working on bank stabilization on the Hardy Rd LWC; Snyder Rd, Gravens Rd, Quarry Rd, Jones Rd, and Fairview Church Rd culverts are next; All four graders are blading road to road, covering their entire areas.
- Asphalt milling on Sand Run Rd at the bridge begins today to prep for asphalt patching later this week.
- Discuss utility permit requests for Gateway Fiber pertaining to the following: 1-34: Mennemeyer, Pear Tree, Witte, and S. Moore School Rds.; 1-35: Mennemeyer and Sugar Grove Rds.; 1-36: Zoar Church, County Farm, Bell, Schemmer, Big Creek, and Godt Rds.; 1-37: Linns Mills, Trackside Farm, and Fieth Rds.; 1-38: N. Moore School, Cave Farm, Giles, and Trackside Farm Rds.; 1-39: Russell, Linns Mill, and Camp Charren Rds.
- There was a meeting for the Outer Rd project last Wednesday. MoDOT denied the roundabout. Tapley requested a written statement regarding the reasons for the denial so he (and the Commission) would know what to tell residents that ask.


Robert Henebry, Project Management

- Henebry presented his report on current projects: Discussed current bid review: Concrete finishings at the Justice Center, Jail improvements to booking, Janitorial Supplies, Culvert pipes, and Vending Services are all due on December 5, 2023, and Inmate Monitoring System is due on November 14, 2023; Reported Sheriff's Department inmate monitors have been placed out for bid, Met with engineer to start the design of medical expansion, Meeting with School and Sheriff's officer regarding LPR's (license plate recognition); Highway Department windows have been installed and existing office remodel has begun; Crisis Stabilization Center doors were installed, fire alarm installation has begun, Drywall will begin in 2 weeks, and parking lot grading is complete; Courthouse Recorder's office computer room painting is complete and work stations are ordered and will be installed in 2-3 weeks, New CAT 5e cables for additional cameras will be ran as well as a new line to the fire panel. Fire panel cable needs to be replaced as it's been damaged.

New/Unfinished Business

- Dave Hoeft, resident, spoke to Tapley and to the Commission concerning the asphaltting of Blackmore Rd and any other construction along his route.
- Bids were open on July 25, 2023, and read aloud for the following: LC Jail Walk-In Cooler/Freezer Combo: Rapids (DASCOA, INC), \$81,668.68; Edward Don & Company, \$80,862.12; Index Restaurant Supply, \$80,888.00. Award pending.
- Commissioner Mueller made a motion to award the LC Jail Walk-In Cooler/Freezer Combo to Rapids (DASCOA, INC), \$81,668.68. Commissioner Bass second. All eyes to carry the motion.

There being no other business before the County Commission at this time, the meeting thereupon was adjourned until Tuesday, November 7, 2023.
