2024 Lincoln County Presidential Caucus Information

Missouri Lawmakers have changed the Presidential Primary Election to allow the political parties to administer their own candidate selection process. The processes are set by the political parties and the Lincoln County Clerk's Office will share the most current information provided by the parties.

Lincoln County Republican Party

Lincoln County Republicans will caucus on March 2, 2024, at the Troy R-III Ninth Grade Center located at 80 Elm Tree Road, Moscow Mills, MO 63362. Doors will open at 9 a.m. The doors will be closed at 10 a.m. and the caucus will be called to order. As with any election process, you will need to present a valid, unexpired, government issued photo ID at the door before entering the caucus. Lincoln County Democratic Party

The Lincoln County Democrat's process will include mail-in voting and in-person voting. Mail-in ballots can be requested from the party between February 1, 2024, and March 12, 2024, and voted ballots must be received by 10:00 a.m. on March 23, 2024. On March 23, 2024, from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m., the party will host in-person voting at the Lincoln County Health Department Community Room located at 5 Health Department Drive, Troy, MO 63379. The deadline to register to vote and participate in the Democratic Presidential Preference Primary Election is Wednesday, February 21, 2024. Any registered Lincoln County voter with a voter registration affiliation of Democratic or Unaffiliated can participate. The candidates that will appear on the ballot are Joseph R Biden, Jr, Dean Phillips, Stephen P Lyons, Armondo Perez-Serrato, Marianne Williamson, Jason Michael Palmer, and an option to vote Uncommitted.
