In compliance with the election laws of the State of Missouri, notice is hereby given to the qualified voters of the County of Lincoln that the annual election for the Lincoln County Ambulance District Board of Directors will be held on Tuesday, April 6, 2021.

One (1) director shall be elected for a three (3) year term for Sub District #2 representing the Clark Township.

One (1) director shall be elected for a three (3) year term for Sub District #5 representing the Hawk Point, Louisville, Millwood, Nineveh, Prairie, and Union Townships.

Any qualified voter of said sub-districts may file a form of "Declaration of Candidacy" for the respective office.

Those interested may file with Crystal M. Hall, County Clerk, Room 204 of the Lincoln County Courthouse located at 201 Main Street in Troy. Office hours are Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The clerk's office will be closed on December 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> as well as January 1<sup>st</sup> and January 18<sup>th</sup> in observance of holidays. Office hours are 8:00 am to noon on December 31<sup>st</sup>. Office hours on January 19<sup>th</sup> will be 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Ballot placement will be determined pursuant to Section 115.395.2, RSMo. which states that; Candidates who file on the first day will select a number by random drawing. The random number drawn will determine the candidate's ballot placement. After the first day, candidates will be placed on the ballot in order of their filing.
