Those interested may file with Crystal M. Hall, County Clerk, Room 204 of the Lincoln County Courthouse located at 201 Main Street in Troy. Office hours are Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The clerk’s office will be closed on December 24th and 25th as well as January 1st and January 18th in observance of holidays. Office hours are 8:00 am to noon on December 31st. Office hours on January 19th will be 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Ballot placement will be determined pursuant to Section 115.395.2, RSMo. which states that; Candidates who file on the first day will select a number by random drawing. The random number drawn will determine the candidate’s ballot placement. After the first day, candidates will be placed on the ballot in order of their filing.
