#### Instructions to Voter

- To Vote you must completely darken the oval (●) to the left of your choice using a black ink pen.
- Note the permitted number of choices directly below the title of each candidate office. Do not mark the ballot for more choices than allowed.
- If you are in favor of the proposition or question, darken the oval to the left of the word "YES".
- If you are opposed to the proposition or question, darken the oval to the left of the word "NO".
- If you wish to vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, write the name on the write-in line and darken the oval to the left of the line. Only a declared write-in candidate will be counted.
- If you mark the ballot for more choices than permitted, that contest or question will not be counted.
- If you make a mistake, or want to change your vote, you may return your ballot to an election official and receive a new ballot. The election official shall mark "SPOILED" across the ballot and place it in an envelope marked "SPOILED BALLOTS" and then issue a new ballot to you.
