- To Vote you must completely darken the oval ( ) to the left of your choice using a black ink pen.
- Note the permitted number of choices directly below the title of each candidate office. Do not mark the ballot for more choices than allowed
- If you are in favor of the proposition or question, darken the oval to the left of the word "YES".
- If you are opposed to the proposition or question, darken the oval to the left of the word "NO".
- If you wish to vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, write the name on the write-in line and darken the oval to the left of the line. Only a declared write-in candidate will be counted.
- If you mark the ballot for more choices than permitted, that contest or question will not be counted.

The election official shall mark "SPOILED" across the ballot and place it in an envelope marked "SPOILED BALLOTS" and then issue a new ballot to you.</li> </ul>
