REGISTER TO VOTE IN LINCOLN COUNTY

In order to register to vote in the Lincoln County, a person must:

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Must be 17 ½ years of age (18 years old by Election Day)
- Must be a resident of Lincoln County

To register in person, come to the Lincoln County Courthouse at 201 Main Street in Troy. The Voter Registration Office is in Room 204. You may also register to vote at the Troy License Bureau located at 850 E Cherry Street in Troy, at the Lincoln County Health Department located off of Highway H at 5 Health Department Drive in Troy, or, online at the Missouri Secretary of State's website www.sos.mo.gov

You may also fill out the <u>Lincoln County Voter Registration Form</u> on this website. Complete the form then print, sign, and mail the form to:

Missouri Law requires that a resident of the State of Missouri must register to vote at their residential address by the deadline in order to be eligible to vote in an election. The deadline to register to vote in a specific election is 5:00 PM on the fourth Wednesday prior to that election.

Those registered to vote in the State must update their address each time that they move. Address changes may be made in person at any office listed above, online at the Missouri Secretary of State's website www.sos.mo.gov, or by completing a new form and mailing it to the address above.

Keeping your registration up to date ensures that you have no delays at the polls on Election Day. Notify the Voter Registration Office in person, online, or in writing to the above address if:

- You have a legal name change
- You have moved to a new address within the county
- You have moved out of Lincoln County (you must register with the Election Authority in the new county)
